

Sanjay Saint, MD, MPH, MACP, is the Chief of Medicine at the VA Ann Arbor Healthcare System, the George Dock Professor of International Medicine at the University of Michigan, and a Special Correspondent to the New England Journal of Medicine. He is an international expert in medical education and in patient safety and has authored 400 peer-reviewed papers.

He has co-authored several books, including
Teaching Inpatient Medicine: What Every Physician
Needs to Know and The Saint-Chopra Guide to
Inpatient Medicine. In 2016 he received the Mark
Wolcott Award from the Department of Veterans
Affairs as the National VA Physician of the Year and
was elected as an international honorary Fellow of
the Royal College of Physicians (FRCP). In 2017 he
was awarded the Distinguished Mentor Award from
the University of Michigan. In 2019 he was named
a Master of the American College of Physicians
(MACP).
