Application Guidelines for the First Call for the 2024 UTokyo Foundation for Supporting International Students Scholarship, Nagashima Masanori Scholarship and Masuda M Masato Scholarship

1. Eligibility

Self-financed international students who satisfy all of the following criteria.

- (1) Applicant must have good academic record and character.
- (2) Applicant must be enrolled at the University of Tokyo as a student in regular courses or a research student as of April 2024 and is expected to be registered throughout the year.

(As for the Nagashima Masanori Scholarship, only students in regular courses are eligible to apply. As for the Masuda M Masato Scholarship, students who are from Taiwan will be prioritized.)

- X Students who will still be registered even though they exceed the standard course duration may also apply.
- (3) Applicants who require assistance with their tuition fees.
 - Applicants who are still employed by and receiving salaries from government agencies or other organizations in their home country while they are studying overseas, or any applicants receiving financial support (in excess of JPY 50,000 per month) from other sources are not eligible to apply.
- (4) Applicants must have Status of Residence as "Student" as specified in the Immigration Control and Refugees Recognition Act (Government Ordinance No.319, October 4, 1951) Appended Table 1-4) as of April 2024.

2. Scholarship Amount

JPY 50,000 per month

3. Period of Payment

- 12 month period (April 2024 to March 2025)
- *Extension of the period of payment will not be made.

4. Number of Scholarships Available

- 6 for UTokyo Foundation for Supporting International Students Scholarship
- 5 for Nagashima Masanori Scholarship
- 4 for Masuda M Masato Scholarship
- *1 Through selection, it is decided if the applicant selected as the recipient of UTokyo Foundation for Supporting International Students Scholarship, of Nagashima Masanori Scholarship or of Masuda M Masato Scholarship.
- *2 A meeting with Mr. Masanori Nagashima will be held once a year. It is expected to attend the meeting if selected as the recipient of Nagashima Masanori Scholarship.
- *3 It is expected to write a thank-you letter to Mr. MASUDA Masato if selected as the recipient of Masuda M Masato Scholarship (The details will be informed later).

5. Documents for Submission

- (1) Application for Scholarships (typed in Japanese or English) (Form 1) 1 copy
- (2) Letter of recommendation from supervising faculty (Form 2) 1 copy
- (3) Copy of Residence Card 1 copy

6. Period and Method of Application

Contact the relevant office of applicant's affiliated Graduate School

7. Selection and Result

The Executive Vice President will make the selection based on the recommendations of the Deans of the Graduate Schools. The applicants will be notified of the selection results through the Dean of their affiliated Graduate School.

8. Miscellaneous

Even after selection as recipients of the scholarships, if the fund determines that any one of the following points applies to the recipient, the selection decision will be revoked. (Where necessary, repayment of the scholarships already paid deemed may be demanded.)

- (2) If the recipients go on a study abroad program or leaves the university.
- (3) Any other reasons where the recipient loses eligibility to receive the scholarship.
